On behalf of Animal Friends of the Valleys I would like to thank you for your generous support in 2009. We have been able to help many animals and continue our many programs because of your contribution.

2009 was a very busy year for Animal Friends of the Valleys. We have been able to continue our mission by:

- Placing 543 animals in AFV foster homes that were ultimately adopted
- Vaccinating 2,987 animals at our monthly low cost vaccination clinic
- Transporting 1,999 animals for spaying/neutering. This will prevent thousands of unwanted births
- AFV offered \$37,450.00 in spay/neuter vouchers to the public
- We expanded our Senior Pet Day program to now include Cherry Hills Club in Sun City. This is a program that is enjoyed by both the senior citizens and the animals
- AFV cared for 9853 animals in the shelter in 2009
- Our Humane and Animal Control Officers handled 21,879 calls and drove 118,849 miles
- 447 volunteers donated 14,775 hours at AFV
- Provided humane euthanasia both at the shelter and in homes to animals at the request of the owner due to health and behavior problems
- Our humane educator reached 6,445 children and 429 adults in 2009.
- AFV was awarded the animal control / sheltering contract for the city of Wildomar
- AFV held 60 potentially dangerous dog/public nuisance hearings

AFV was voted 2009 Lake Elsinore Chamber of Commerce "Non-profit of the Year. We will continue to work for and on behalf of the animals.
